## PAPAMOA FOOTBALL CLUB FIXTURE DEFAULT/POSTPONEMENT SANCTIONS .

## POLICY

Papamoa FC receives monetary sanctions from two governing bodies that being Northern Region Football League and Waikato Bay of Plenty Football, who administer the competitions Papamoa FC have teams participating in.

These sanctions are for the defaulting of scheduled fixtures.

## PURPOSE

Papamoa FC seeks to recover the monetary sanction imposed from the offending team when this occurs.

## PROCESS

Any monetary sanction received will be passed on by Papamoa FC to the relevant team who have 14 days from receipt of the invoice to pay.

The invoice is sent to the manager or coach of the team.

The fine is applicable to the members of that team and failure to pay could result in the club taking further action.

Whereby the default was caused by weather (which caused the initial postponement) and there was no mutually acceptable time to play the fixture, the Board of Papamoa FC may choose to waive the imposition of a sanction upon a team proving a genuine effort has been made to get the fixture played.

Coaches and Team Managers will be given a copy of the default of fixtures policy at the coaches pre season meeting in February prior to the season commencing.
